Dr. Andraž Teršek, ass.prof., born in 1975,

helds a Doctor's degree in Constitutional Law, obtained at the Faculty of Law, the University of Ljubljana (2008).

He began his academic career as an Assistant at the Chair of Theory and Sociology of Law at that Faculty from 1999 to 2008. He is the former assistant editor of the *Dignitas* – The Slovenian Journal for Human Rights, editor of a few collections of scientific papers and author of several monographs (over 10), numerous scientific articles, essays and research papers. He is the initiator, cofounder and first editor of the *REVUS*-International Journal for Constitutional Theory and Legal Philosophy.

As a constitutional scholar, legal philosopher and political theorist he teaches at the Faculty for Educational Sciences Koper, Faculty for Humanities Koper, Faculty for Management Koper (all at the University of Primorska, Koper) and at the European Faculty of Law in Ljubljana and Nova Gorica (Slovenia).

He recieved a prestigeus academic award "Prometheus of Science – excellence in publicly communicating science" two times.

In 2014 his first novel *Brutalci* came out. In 2018 he published his first book with poetics and phisolophical poems *Razmetanje pozlačenega drobca; Po-etika*.

He is a regular member of the official national list "Ten most influential lawyers," sponsored by the biggest national media for lawyers and legal issues.
