Petra Ferk je diplomirala pri 22 letih na Pravni fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani z oceno cum laude. Po končanem študiju se je zaposlila na Slovenski odškodninski družbi, nato pa je kot svetovalka začela delati v javnem podjetju Kontrola zračnega prometa Slovenije, d.o.o. Leta 2008 je na Pravni fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani uspešno zagovarjala magistrsko nalogo pod mentorstvom prof. dr. Rajka Pirnata. Istega leta je v soavtorstvu z Boštjanom Ferkom napisala monografijo z naslovom Javne službe, državne pomoči in javno-zasebna partnerstva. Leta 2008 je prejela priznanje Zveze društev pravnikov za mlado pravnico. Leta 2023 je prejela priznanje Zveze društev pravnikov za delo v organih zveze in njenih članicah.

Je avtorica več strokovnih in znanstvenih člankov doma in v tujini. Med daljšimi študijskimi aktivnostmi v tujini je treba omeniti raziskovalno delo, ki ga je opravila za magistrsko nalogo in za doktorsko disertacijo kot štipendistka na Inštitutu Maxa Plancka za mednarodno in primerjalno pravo v Hamburgu. Stažirala je na Sodišču Evropske Unije v Luksemburgu, in se v Dublinu na Irskem izpopolnjevala v angleškem jeziku ter opravljala tudi raziskovalno delo za doktorsko disertacijo.

V okviru Inštituta pokriva predvsem raziskovalno dejavnost na vseh področjih delovanja Inštituta, mednarodno sodelovanje in prenos znanja. Kot izredna profesorica za javno upravo je habilitirana in predava na Novi univerzi, kjer predava pri predmetih Pravo javnih služb, Upravni sistemi, Pravo javnih naročil in koncesij in Javno-zasebna partnerstva. V zadnjem času se ukvarja zlasti z aktualnimi vprašanji elektronskega javnega naročanja, projekti pogodbenega zagotavljanja prihranka energije, trajnostno usmerjenega izvajanja javnih projektov, zagotavljanjem in financiranjem izvajanja javnih služb in izgradnje javne infrastrukture ter s tem povezanim vprašanjem državnih pomoči.

Petra Ferk je članica upravnega odbora Slovenskega društva za evropsko pravo in sodeluje pri njegovih aktivnosti že od ustanovitve naprej. Hkrati je tudi članica upravnega odbora Mednarodnega združenja za evropsko pravo (Federation Internationale du droit Europeen – FIDE) in članica upravnega odbora Mednarodne akademije za primerjalno pravo (International Academy of Comparative Law – IACL).

Petra Ferk je nacionalna korespondentka za European Procurement & Public Private Partnership Law Review. V okviru Upravne akademije pri Ministrstvu za javno upravo pa nastopa kot izvajalka seminarjev in izobraževanj na temo javno-zasebnega partnerstva.

Petra je tudi zelo aktivna pri globalnem prenosu najboljših praks s področja uveljavljanja ciljev trajnostnega razvoja z javno-zasebnimi partnerstvi, ki poteka pod okriljem Gospodarske komisije Združenih narodov za Evropo (UNECE) - UNECE PPP and Infrastructure Evaluation and Rating System (PIERS) in je uvrščena na seznam ocenjevalcev projektov po metodologiji PIERS pri Sekretariatu UNECE.

Petra Ferk is one of the Founders at the Institute for Public-Private Partnership, Slovenia. She is also an Assistant Professor for Public Administration at the Graduate School of Government and European Studies, Slovenia.

Petra Ferk graduated cum laude from the Faculty of Law. After her studies, she started working at Slovenska odškodninska družba, Ltd. and later switched to a position of a Advisor at Slovenia Control, Ltd.. In 2008, she successfully defended her Master Thesis, her mentor being prof. Rajko Pirnat. That same year, she co-authored a monograph Javne službe, državne pomoči in javno-zasebna partnerstva [Public Services, State Aids, and Public-Private Partnerships]. In 2008, she was also awarded the “Young Lawyer Award” by the Slovenian Law Association. In 2023, she

received recognition from the Association of Lawyers for her work in the organs of the association and its members.

As said, Petra is the co-author of a legal monograph and also the author of numerous articles dealing mainly with public-private partnerships, public procurement, services of general (economic) interest, and state aid. Among her activities abroad, her most prominent work is a research, conducted in Dublin as well as research for her master's and doctoral theses at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative and International Private Law in Hamburg, Germany, for which she received scholarship. She additionally improved her professional skills as a stagier at the European Court of Justice in the cabinet of Judge of the Court of First Instance of European Communities, Mrs. Ingrida Labucka.

Within the Institute for Public-Private Partnership, Petra advises on complex legal issues within the areas of operation of the Institute, as well as covering the fields of research, international cooperation, and knowledge transfer. As an Associate assistant professor for public administration at the New University, she lectures about public services law, public-private partnerships, public procurement, administrative systems, administrative law and procedure. Recently, she has been actively engaging in discussions on e-procurement, energy performance contracting projects, sustainable procurement, provision and financing of public services, public infrastructure, and the related issue of state aid.

Petra is a member of the board of the Slovenian Association for European Law and participates in its activities since its establishment. She also holds the positions of a member of the management board at Federation Internationale du droit Europeen – FIDE and International Academy of Comparative Law – IACL.

Petra is the national correspondent for European Procurement & Public Private Partnership Law Review, and is active in promoting best practices on PPPs within the trainings organised by the UNECE International PPP Centre of Excellence. She is on the list of lecturers for public-private partnerships at the Academy for Administration of the Slovenian Ministry of Public Administration.

Petra is also very active in the global transfer of best practices in the field of implementing sustainable development goals through public-private partnerships, which takes place under the auspices of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) - UNECE PPP and Infrastructure Evaluation and Rating System (PIERS) and is listed as a Project Evaluator rostered by the UNECE Secretariat.
