It is the nature of humanistic knowledge to entail the interweaving of the world with regard to its identities and its differences. The search for responsibility for contemporary occurrences in the world often forgets that—insofar as we are unable to respond to existentially concerned questions—we do not have a world at all, only perhaps a half-world or a non-world. Writing of poems, reading of books, creation of images, exhibitions of painting, building of edifices, archeological finds, theatre performances, musical events, screens, computers, telephones, letters, archives, museums, journal entries, critique, biographies, manuscripts, travel diaries, lectures, reports, discussions, explanations, news, prayers, pleas, promises ... all these are ways of corresponding within existence, which we share and which perhaps divide us, but which—first and foremost—are bestowed upon us. The “Humanistic Correspondences” attempt to offer such cohabitation through conversation.
