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Vsebina:	Content (Syllabus outline):
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Upravljanje nepremičnin in gospodarjenje z njimi ter poznavanje zakonitosti prostora so temeljni elementi, na katerih gradijo razvoj uspešne ekonomije razvitih držav. Zemljiška knjiga, zemljiški kataster in kataster stavb so v Sloveniji temeljne, *de iure* evidence o nepremičninah. Namensko in sistematično spremljanje in evidentiranje podatkov o nepremičninah pomeni združevanje in povezovanje lokacijskih in tehničnih podatkov o nepremičninah ter podatkov o pravicah na nepremičninah in pravnih dejstvih v zvezi z nepremičninami.

Predmet Evidentiranje nepremičnin na dodiplomski ravni študija obravnava naslednja osnovna področja vsebin in raziskovalnih vprašanj, ki se nanašajo na:

- Upravljanje nepremičnin, registri, katastri, institucionalni in organizacijski okviri
- Zemljiški kataster – vsebina, postopki, vzpostavitev in vzdrževanje
- Kataster stavb – vsebina, postopki, vzpostavitev in vzdrževanje
- Izvajanje geodetskih storitev za potrebe evidentiranja nepremičnin
- Register nepremičnin – namen, vsebina, vzpostavitev in vzdrževanje
- Množično vrednotenje nepremičnin z obdavčitvijo nepremičnin - osnove
- Prostorske in geodetske evidence
- Zemljiška knjiga – zgodovinski razvoj, vsebina, načela, vzpostavitev in vzdrževanje
- Elektronska zemljiška knjiga
- Zemljiškoknjizični postopki
- Vknjižba in vpis etažne lastnine v zemljiško knjigo – osnovni principi

Real estate management and knowledge of spatial data infrastructure are the basic elements on which they build prosperous economies of developed countries. In Slovenia, land registry, land cadastre and building cadastre are fundamental, *de iure* records of real estate. Deliberately and systematically monitoring and recording of real estate data means integrating and linking locational and technical real estate data and data on rights to real estate and legal facts relating to real estate.

The course on Recording of Real Estate at the undergraduate level addresses the following basic areas of content and research issues related to:

- Real estate management, registers, cadastre, institutional and organizational framework
- Land cadastre – content, processes, establishment and maintenance
- Building cadastre – content, processes, establishment and maintenance
- Implementation of geodetic services for the needs of the real estate recording
- Register of real estate – purpose, content, establishment and maintenance
- Mass valuation of real estate with taxation of real estate - basics
- Spatial and geodetic records
- Land register – historical development, content, principles, establishment and maintenance
- Electronic land register
- Land registration processes
- Registration and entry of condominiums into the land register – basic principles

Reference nosilca / Lecturer's references:

Nana Weber je docentka za civilno in gospodarsko pravo na Evropski pravni fakulteti, docentka za delovno pravo na MLC Fakulteti za management in pravo Ljubljana in docentka za poslovne vede na B2 Visoki šoli za poslovne vede. Leta 2003 je diplomirala na Pravni fakulteti v Ljubljani. Tam je s podiplomskim študijem nadaljevala in leta 2010 magistrirala na področju civilnega in gospodarskega in leta 2013 doktorirala na področju civilnega prava. Leta 2010 je diplomirala še na Akademiji za glasbo.

Poklicno pot v pravu je začela v sodstvu in na različnih stopnjah sodišč, nato je delala na državnem pravobranilstvu, v odvetniški pisarni in v kabinetu ministra za javno upravo. Leta 2016 je začela samostojno pot in danes vodi Odvetniško družbo Weber.

Ker si vedno prizadeva za mirno rešitev sporov, je mediatorka v Mediacijskem centru Ljubljana, pri Odvetniški zbornici Slovenije in Ministrstvu za delo družino, socialne zadeve in enake možnosti, poleg tega pa je izvajalka izvensodnega reševanja potrošniških sporov pri Ministrstvu za gospodarski razvoj in tehnologijo.

Je tudi članica državne izpitne komisije za pravniški državni izpit (področje civilnega materialnega in procesnega prava).

Na redni bazi piše strokovne in znanstvene članke iz različnih pravnih področij. Med drugim je ena od avtoric Družinskega zakonika (Uradni list, 2019), avtorica uvodnih pojasnil Družinskega zakonika (GV Založba, Lexpera, 2018), in avtorica zbirke Vprašanja in odgovori iz delovnega prava (GV Založba, Lexpera), v okviru katere sta doslej izšli knjige Prenehanje pogodbe o zaposlitvi (2020), in Ko delavca ni na delu (Dopust, regres in druge odsotnosti z dela (2021)).

She is also a member of the State Examination Board for the State Lawyers' Examination (civil substantive and procedural law).

Nana Weber is assistant professor for civil and corporate law at the European Faculty of Law New University, assistant professor for labour law and assistant professor for business sciences at Ljubljana School of Business. She graduated from the University of Ljubljana Faculty of Law, in

2003. She continued her postgraduate course in the same University and received a Master's degree of Science in 2010 (Civil and Commercial Law), and Doctor's degree of Science in 2013 (Civil Law). In 2010 she graduated in Music Pedagogy at the Musical Arts in 2010.

Her professional legal career began at different levels of the court, then she worked at the State's Attorney Office, at lawyer and at Ministry of Public Administration. In the year 2016 she began her independent career and today she runs her own law firm – *Odvetniška družba Weber*. As law professional she always strives for peaceful resolution of conflicts.

She is certified mediator at the Ljubljana Mediation Centre, the Bar Association of Slovenia and at Ministry of Labour, Family, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities and the provider of out-of-court settlement of consumer disputes at Ministry of Economic Development and Technology.

On regular basis she writes professional and scientific articles. Among other things, she is one of the authors of the Family code (Uradni list 2019), the author of the introductory explanations of the Family Code (GV Založba, Lexpera, 2018) and author of professional collection Labour Law Questions and Answers (GV Založba, Lexpera), in which so far the book Termination of employment contract (2020) and the book When the worker is not at work (Annual leave, payment for annual leave, and other absences from work) (2021) were published.
