Cilji in kompetence:

Predmet v okviru splošnega dela obravnava predvsem problem volje pacienta, v okviru posebnega dela medicinskega kazenskega prava pa posebnosti t.i. medicinskih inkriminacij (ki v slovenski pravosodni, še bolj pa medicinski praksi povzročajo značilne razlagalne težave), posebej pa analizira potrebo po novih interpretacijah in iz njih izvirajočih novih inkriminacijah.

Posebna odlika predmeta je sonosilstvo specialistov pravnih znanosti in za sodno medicino. Z vidika sodne medicine, prilagojene za pravnike predmet nudi temeljna znanja ocenjevanja telesnih poškodb, zastrupitev, razlogov smrti in podobnih okoliščin, ključnih za presojo obstoja kaznivega dejanja zoper telo človeka, protipravnosti tega dejanja in krivde storilca. Nudi tudi temeljni vpogled v ocenjevanje medicinske napake in v medicinsko deontologijo. Na ta način predmet na intenziven način enakovredno združuje izkušnje pravne in sodno-medicinske oziroma medicinsko deontološke znanosti ter teoretična spoznanja dveh ved s spoznanji njune prakse.

Objectives and competences:

Within the framework of the general part, the course primarily deals with the problem of the patient's will, and within the framework of the special part of medical criminal law, the specifics of the so-called medical incriminations (which in Slovenian judicial, and even more so, medical practice cause characteristic interpretation problems), and in particular analyzes the need for new interpretations and new incriminations arising from them.

A special feature of the course is the participation of specialists in legal sciences and forensic medicine. From the point of view of forensic medicine, adapted for lawyers, the subject provides basic knowledge of assessing physical injuries, poisoning, causes of death and similar circumstances, which are crucial for assessing the existence of a crime against a person's body, the illegality of this act and the guilt of the perpetrator. It also provides fundamental insight into the assessment of medical malpractice and into medical deontology. In this way, the course intensively combines the experiences of legal and forensic medicine, or medical deontology, as well as the theoretical knowledge of the two sciences with the knowledge of their practice.

Predvideni študijski rezultati:

Prof. dr. Jože Balažic je redni profesor za področje sodne medicine in medicinske deontologije ter višji zdravnik specialist sodne medicine. Vodi Katedro za sodno medicino na Medicinski fakulteti Univerze v Mariboru, pred upokojitvijo pa je bil dolgoletni predstojnik Inštituta za sodno medicino MF UL in predstojnik Katedre za sodno medicino in medicinsko deontologijo na MF UL v zadnjem mandatu. Kot dolgoletni predavatelj na obeh medicinskih fakultetah ter na Pravni fakulteti UL, je prenašal svoje bogato znanje na številne generacije študentov, bil mentor številnim specializantom, magistrantom in doktorandom. Kot učitelj in raziskovalec je objavil številne članke in druga dela v domači in tuji strokovni literaturi.

Prof. dr. Jože Balažic is a full professor in the field of forensic medicine and medical deontology and a senior doctor specializing in forensic medicine. He heads the Department of Forensic Medicine at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Maribor, and before his retirement, he was the long-term head of the Institute of Forensic Medicine of the Ministry of Health UL and the head of the Department of Forensic Medicine and Medical Deontology at the Ministry of Health UL in his last term. As a long-term lecturer at both medical faculties and at the UL Faculty of Law, he passed on his rich knowledge to many generations of students, mentoring many specialists, master's and doctoral students. As a teacher and researcher, he published numerous articles and other works in domestic and foreign professional literature.
